The Commission for Health Services has developed rules and regulations to govern environmental controls based on epidemiological statistics. Environmental Health has programs that addresses these rules and regulations as well as other activities in training, education, and surveillance in areas of environmental concerns.

The services offered include:

- Animal control
- Bacteriological-chemical and other water testing
- On-site wastewater
- Well inspections and permits
- Pool & tattoo inspections
- Food, lodging, and institutional sanitation
- Child Care Centers
- Environmental education programs
- Lead investigations

Clinical Services

The Jackson County Department of Public Health offers a variety of clinical services including:

- Immunizations for all ages
- Pregnancy testing
- Blood pressure screening
- Communicable diseases screening
- HIV/STD testing and counseling

Adult Health

An Adult Wellness Screening Clinic is available to anyone 18 years of age and older who is an established patient with a physician.

The Wellness Screening includes:

- Blood pressure check
- Height and weight
- Laboratory testing
- Physical (optional)

Cancer Screening includes:

- Breast exam, pelvic exam, and PAP test (Women only)
- PSA (Men 50 and older; earlier with risk factors)

Child Health

- School Health Assessment
- Sports Physical
- Immunizations

Women's Health

- High Risk Perinatal
- Prenatal
- Family Planning
- Women's Breast and Cervical Cancer Control Program (BCCCP)
- WISEWOMAN Program



Laboratory Services

- Provider ordered lab testing available
- Department of Transportation (DOT) and Non-DOT urine drug screens (with contract only)
- Water testing (Coliform, E. coli, and nitrate)

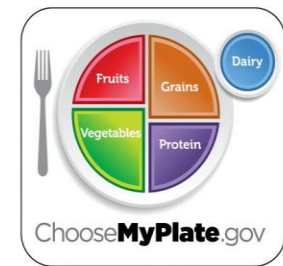
